Football for People with an Intellectual Disability

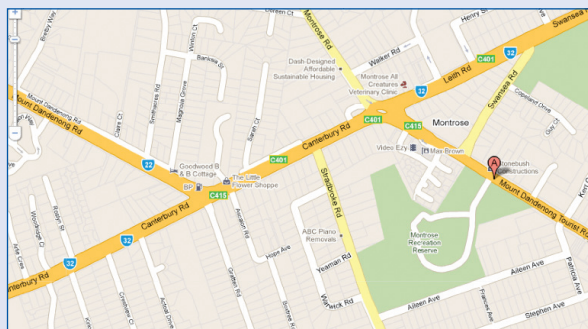

Transport

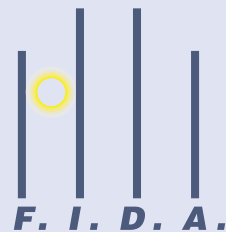
Players are expected to provide their own transport to and from activities.
